The event location is Eureka City Lake, five miles north of Eureka, KS. The main campsite is Phillips Cabin, located on the northwest corner of the lake. The site is available to our group after 3:00 pm on Friday, June 14th. All campers should plan to vacate the main site no later than noon on Sunday, June 16, 2013. If you wish to arrive earlier or stay later at the lake, contact Eureka City Hall, 620-583-6140, to arrange for an individual camp site.

If you don't wish to camp, there is lodging available in the town of Eureka, and reservations should be made well in advance.

We will have three different group ride formats scheduled for June 15th, and possibly an afternoon ride on the 14th, and morning ride on the 16th.

Rides start around 9:00 am on Saturday, June 15th with a rider meeting at 8:00 am sharp.

The three group ride formats scheduled for June 15th will be led by experienced Backroads Touring - KANSAS! ride leaders. Patrol sizes will range between 8 to 10 riders. Formats incude:

- a.) An "advanced" and challenging ride on primarily minimum maintenance roads. Fastest ride pace.
- b.) A moderately technical "**intermediate**" ride on gravel and minimum maintenance roads. Quick ride pace.
- c.) A "**scenic**" ride for novice/experienced riders. Dirt, gravel and some asphalt roads. This ride will include long sections of open-range riding. Numerous scenic stops. Modest ride pace.
- * Cost is \$50 per rider for paid registrations received by May 15, 2013 and \$60 per rider thereafter. Registration fee includes camping at the Phillips Cabin area, a barbecue dinner Saturday night, eligibility for door prizes, and an event T-Shirt. Registration closing date is Saturday, June 1, 2013, unless registration fills before that date, whichever occurs first.
- * No cancellation refunds after May 25, 2013.
